## Ayushman yojana e card

Ayushman Bharat PMJAY eCard: As many as 10 crore Ayushman Bharat PMJAY eCards have been issued in about 350 days of launch of the system, said Varun Jhaveri, Officer on special service to the CEO, Ayushman Bharat. Jhaveri tweeted, 10 CRORE #AyushmanBharat PMJAY eCards issued in about 350 days! With a life saved, you save an entire family from slipping into poverty. From villages to subways and from cancer to bypass, #AyushmanBharat is quietly making India healthy. 1st step towards \$5 trillion economy. According to the official PMJAY portal, as many as 15,968 hospitals have been empanelled under the system. The total number of beneficiaries admitted to hospital under the scheme is 40,93,453. Ayushman Bharat – Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on September 23, 2018 at Ranchi, Jharkhand. The first of its kind health insurance system in India provides a cover of up to Rs 5 lakh per family per year, for secondary and tertiary hospitalization care, benefitting over 10.74 crore vulnerable families. PMJAY provides cashless and paperless access to services for the recipient at the service. As many as 20,000 health and wellness centers have also been commissioned under the Ayushman Bharat system. Recipients of Ayushman Bharat can control their right by four means. They can self-check either through the Am I Eligible Portal and the Ayushman Bharat PM-JAY Mobile App. They can also call toll-free numbers 14555 or 1800-11-564, or visit the nearest empanelled hospital. Under the Ayushman Bharat system, the government has set up 1.5 million health centers across the country to bring health care closer to the homes of the people. The government recently said that about 41 lakh recipients of the Ayushman Bharat system have saved Rs 12,000 crore so far on health spending since the launch of the system. A total of 17,000 hospitals have been empanelled so far under this system. More than 4.1 million (41 lakh) people have become recipients under this scheme and have thus saved a total of approximately 120 billion Indian rupees (Rs 12000 crore) on health care expenses, Union Health Minister Harsh Vardhan had recently said at the 72nd session of the WHO Regional Committee for Southeast Asia. State-owned UTI Infrastructure Technology and Services Ltd (UTIITSL) on Tuesday said it has signed a pact with the National Health Authority (NHA) to provide printing of for the recipients of Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY). UTIITSL will provide printing services and support the receiver identification and verification process in issuing e-cards to recipients of the AB-PMJAY system, the company said in a statement. About 53 crore recipients under AB-PMJAY are eligible for an annual health insurance coverage of ₹5 lakh to utilize cashless secondary and tertiary care anywhere in the country in their empanelled caregiver. UTIITSL will leverage its existing pan-India network to reach at ground level to identify recipients under the AB-PMJAY system, UTIITSL MD and CEO Vijay Kumar Jain said in the statement. He also added that it will also help them in completing the online validation process for recipient identification systems by AB-PMJAY through their centers across different locations across the country. As of now, there are 23,000 public and private hospitals for the AB-PMJAY system. NHA Vice President Vipul Agarwal said that AB-PMJAY aims to target over 10.74 crore poor, deprived rural families and the professional category of urban workers' families identified according to the Socio-Economic Caste Bill (SECC) 2011 database. In less than two years, 1.2 crore cashless treatments worth ₹ 15,000 crore have been provided, Agarwal said.
